The new issue is about to be released on the first of November.

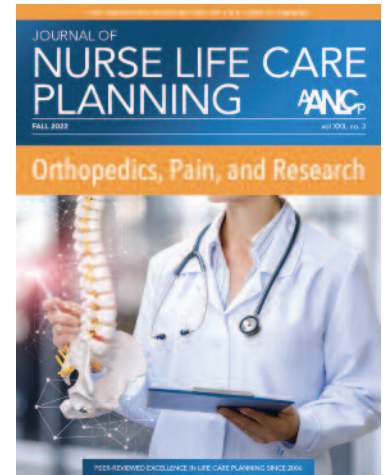

Lifeline Mentorship

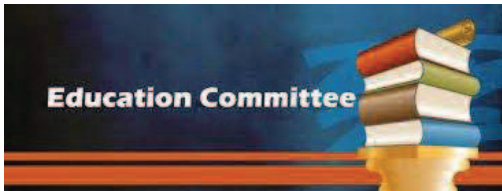


AANLCP offers a Lifeline Mentorship program for its premier members. This program is outlined to assist members in various areas of life care planning practice: from business development

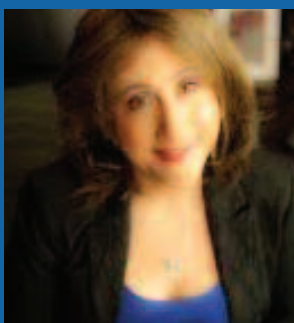
