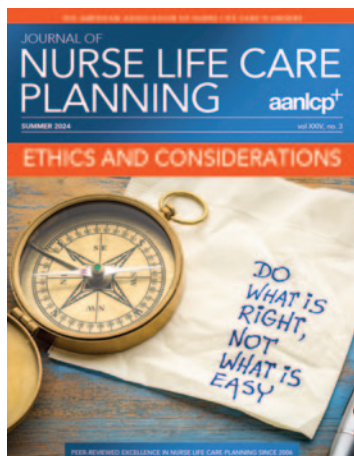
Survey 3 gift card winners were Garson Caruso, Jeff Cockrum, Valerie Parisi, and Shaun Server. We thank everyone for participating.

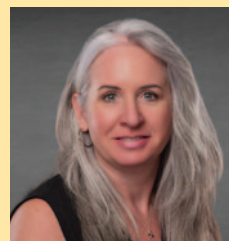
